## Intended Use

Salsa Cable Port Frame Plugs help guide internally routed housing through the frame, keeping the inside of the frame clean and housing free from rattling.

## Compatibility

There are two plug shapes, each featuring multiple hole options:

- Double Port Plugs (no cable, and 1 and 2 cable options)
- Single Port Plugs (no cable and 1 cable options)

Both shapes come in the thick or thin version, based on location and/or material they are being used with.

### Carbon frames:

- Thin for single port at the seat tube, thick for all other ports
- Thick for double port

### Metal Frames without Reinforcement Plates:

- Thin (both single and double)

### Metal Frames with Reinforcement Plates:

- Thick (both single and double)

Plugs are available aftermarket sold in variety packs based on thickness:

## Installation

1. Select the appropriate frame plug per the compatibility guidelines listed.

2. Slide the housing into the openings of the frame plug.

3. Begin by installing one corner of a double plug or one side of a single plug. Usually, installing the cable-entry end first is easiest. Work around the edges of the frame plug, fitting the molded grooves of the plug into the opening in the frame.

4. If necessary, use the flat side of a screwdriver to gently press in the final edges of the frame plug.

### Ongoing Maintenance

Periodically check to make sure all edges of the frame ports are properly fitted into the frame.
